As a first step, please create your account for SAS OnDemand for Academics. To register,

visit <https://odamid.oda.sas.com> and click on *Register for an account*. **Remember to choose Region – United States** If you already have a pre-existing account and chose another Region, you will need to set up another account with *United States* as the Region.

After you have successfully created your account, follow these steps:

1. Sign on the Control Center at <https://odamid.oda.sas.com>.
2. Look for the *Enroll in a course* link in the "Enrollments" section near the bottom of the page. Click this link to start the enrollment.
3. Enter the course code, copy from the previous slide:
4. Submit the form.
5. Confirm that this is the correct course and then click the button to finish enrolling.


